

SYC On-Water Emergency Procedures



Make sure that 911 is called!

**If you are using a cell phone, the operator will need to know:
SYC is at 370 North Shore Rd., Spofford, NH 03462
And Location on Lake, description of boats!**

**If you aren't sure about calling 911; MAKE THE CALL!
Listen to your own instincts! Listen to SYC Command!
Not the ill or injured person!
(You don't need their permission to call!)**

Designate someone to stay on the line and someone to relay information:

- **How many ill or injured are there?**
- **Age/gender?**
- **Breathing?**
- **Conscious?**
- **Events? (E.g. allergic reaction, water-related, heart-related, head injury etc.)**

**NOTE: EMS can assist in stabilizing a person in the water.
SYC Command decides to wait for EMS or move injured or ill parties.
Once EMS is on scene, EMS takes command!**

**Designate someone to make sure emergency vehicles can reach the area.
(Either the launch ramp or main dock.)**

It's best if someone can go to North Shore Road to direct EMS personnel.

**25% of SYC members have First Aid or CPR training.
Make sure people at the club know there is an emergency.
You will have assistance!**
